

Call for Papers: Charles Wesley and the Bible

Annual Meeting of the Charles Wesley Society

Nashville, TN October 18-20, 2012

To celebrate the 250th anniversary of Charles Wesley's two-volume work, *Scripture Hymns*, the Charles Wesley Society seeks papers to be presented at its next annual meeting. Proposals are now being accepted for papers that examine Wesley's interaction with the Bible in his work and life. Since the desire is to explore broadly the various ways in which the Bible factored into Charles Wesley's ministry, papers need *not* be limited to considering his two-volume work but could investigate a range of possible topics.

The meeting will be held in Nashville, TN at on October 18-20, 2012.

Those wishing to present a paper should send an abstract of 300 words to the Society's president, Lester Ruth, by email or physical mail by April 1, 2012. Addresses are provided below. Please include a current curriculum vitae.

Note that the Society's Emerging Scholar Program will cover the meeting costs (registration, housing, and meals) of 1 (one) graduate student or junior faculty person selected to present. To be considered for this program, please include a letter from a teacher, advisor, or colleague in support of the application as well as the presentation abstract and CV.
